Discussion of problems: lack of communication between director and SCR board, issues with awards/results, lack of sound system. Marty said problem this year was failure of backup computer. He said he has lost \$1k in sponsorship and was trying to cut costs. Shane pointed out that the nature of marketing races is changing (i.e, social media, upfront marketing); Marty said he has hired someone to take care of this, and has agreed to make changes to improve. Option b was decided and agreed to by the RD.

Howard motioned to accept proposed race series, Dick seconded. Approved.
